

## MLK Day of Service

### Red Cross

Sign up to volunteer at the Red Cross: <http://www.redcross.org/volunteer/become-a-volunteer#step1>

- **Front Desk Office Assistant** – Answer phones, greet guests to the building, sign people in and out, etc. (usually a 4 hour shift 1x/week)
- **Blood Donor Ambassador** – Greet donors at blood drives, assist at the hospitality tables, bring beverages to donors at the request of phlebotomists, etc.
- **Blood Services Transportation Specialist** – During your shift be on hand to drive emergency blood requests to local hospitals (keeps our taxi bills down!)
- **Disaster Responder Trainee** – Respond to local disasters (like home fires) during your shift and provide Red Cross relief services to those affected
- **Disaster Recovery Caseworker** – Assist local individuals who have been affected by a disaster (like a home fire) with follow-up assistance to help with recovery.
- **Communications Team: Social Media Volunteer; Writer/Editor** -- These two separate volunteering positions work directly with the Regional Communications Officer
- **Volunteer Services Team:** Recognition and Appreciation Volunteer; Recruitment Volunteer – These two separate volunteering positions work with Regional Volunteer Director
- **Service to the Armed Forces Casework:** Veterans Treatment Court – Apply Social Work skills to serve veterans in collaboration w/ the Veterans Treatment Court
- **Service to the Armed Forces Medical Treatment Facility:** Multiple volunteer opportunities – Provide assistance at one of the on-base Medical Treatment Facilities in our area
- **Youth Services:** Red Cross Club Coordinator – Work with Red Cross Clubs in local high schools
